

CERTIFICATION OF DEANNA M. HUNT

Deanna M. Hunt, of full age, says:

- 1) I am the Chief Executive Officer of This Is It Productions, Inc. (hereafter TIIP), and I am fully authorized to make this certification.
- 2) This certification is submitted in response to the County's letter dated September 1, 2011 which claimed a refund of \$24,281.68 was due and owing to the County of Union from TIIP for MusicFest 2010.
- 3) As previously explained, since the Union County paid USI, the parking company, and Strike Force the security company, the balance of their contracted amounts (\$24,366.83) in cash for MusicFest 2010 on behalf of TIIP, we did not invoice Union County for "On-Site Production Crew" labor costs which amounted to \$29,190.00 nor for increased costs in the amount of \$3,807.57 for fuel charges associated with Equipment Rental and SBP Industries.
- 4) Since we internally wrote off the "On-Site Production Crew" labor costs and fuel charges, we did not include those costs as an item of expense in the documentation provided to the Union County Prosecutor's Office.
- 5) When this discrepancy was called to our attention it was realized that for strict accounting purposes, the "On-Site Production Crew" labor costs and fuel charges should have been included in the total expenses; and, by letter dated September 13, 2011 we provided our response to the claimed refund and an explanation for the discrepancy.
- 6) TIIP has since provided the County with supporting documents for the "On-Site Production Crew" labor costs of \$29,190.00 and charges associated with Equipment Rental and SBP Industries in the amount of \$3,807.57 for MusicFest 2010.
- 7) Neither the "On-Site Production Crew" labor costs nor the fuel charges are duplicative of any costs and/or expenses previously provided to the Union County Prosecutor's Office.
- 8) The addition of the "On-Site Production Crew" labor costs and fuel charges would actually result in a balance due and owing to TIIP of \$8,715.89 but that amount has been waived by TIIP.

9) I certify that the foregoing statements are, to the best of my knowledge and belief, true and accurate. I am aware that if any of these statements are willfully false I am subject to punishment.
